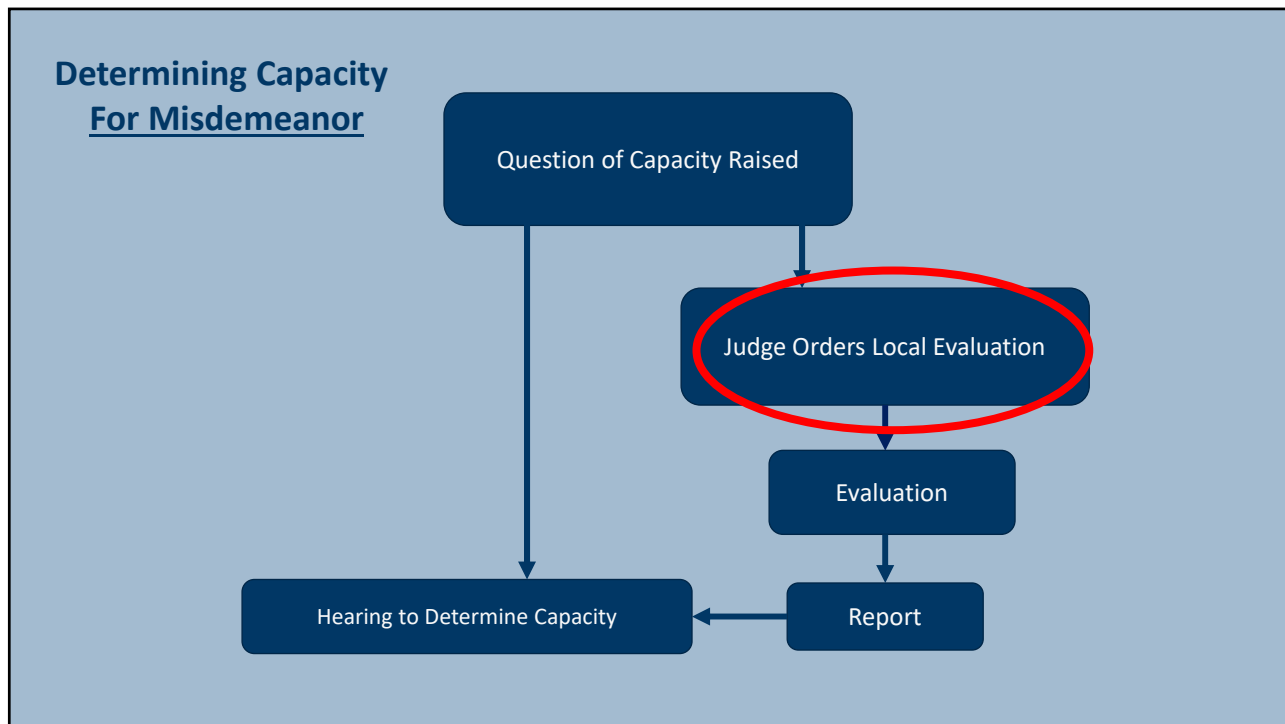

Forensic evaluations for misdemeanors must be done through a local forensic examiner. There is no option for an evaluation at Central Regional Hospital for misdemeanors.

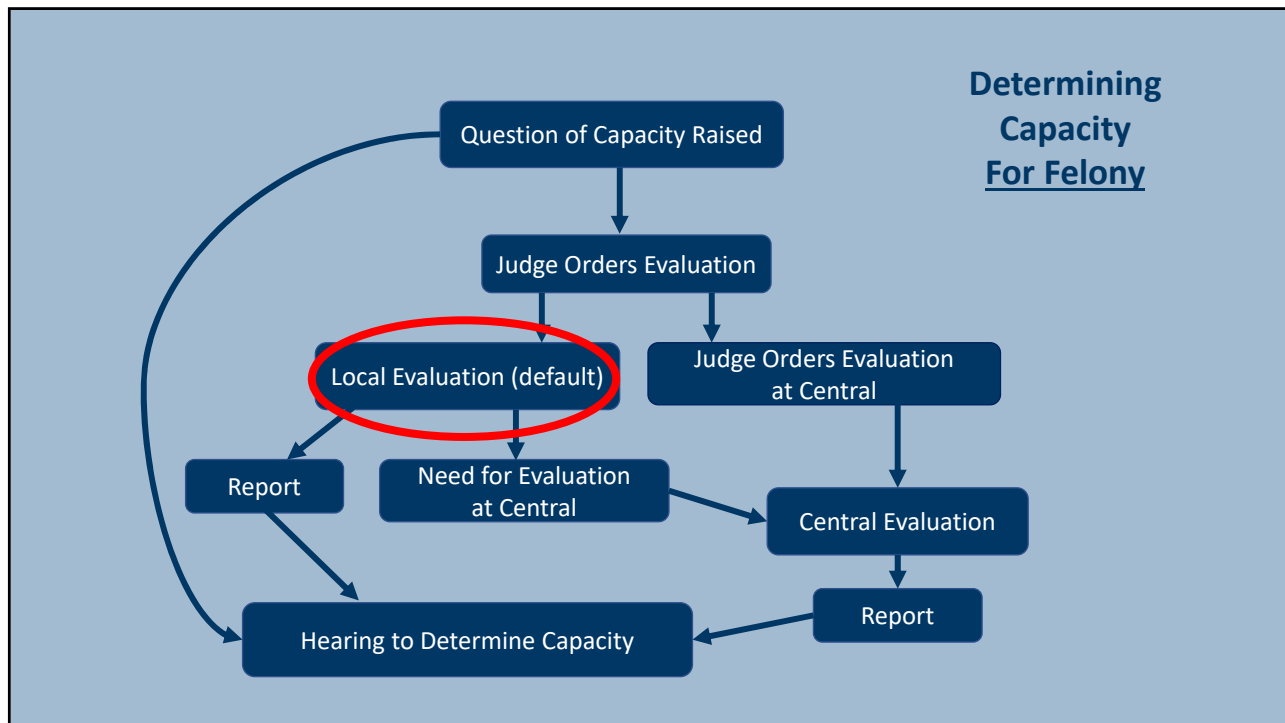

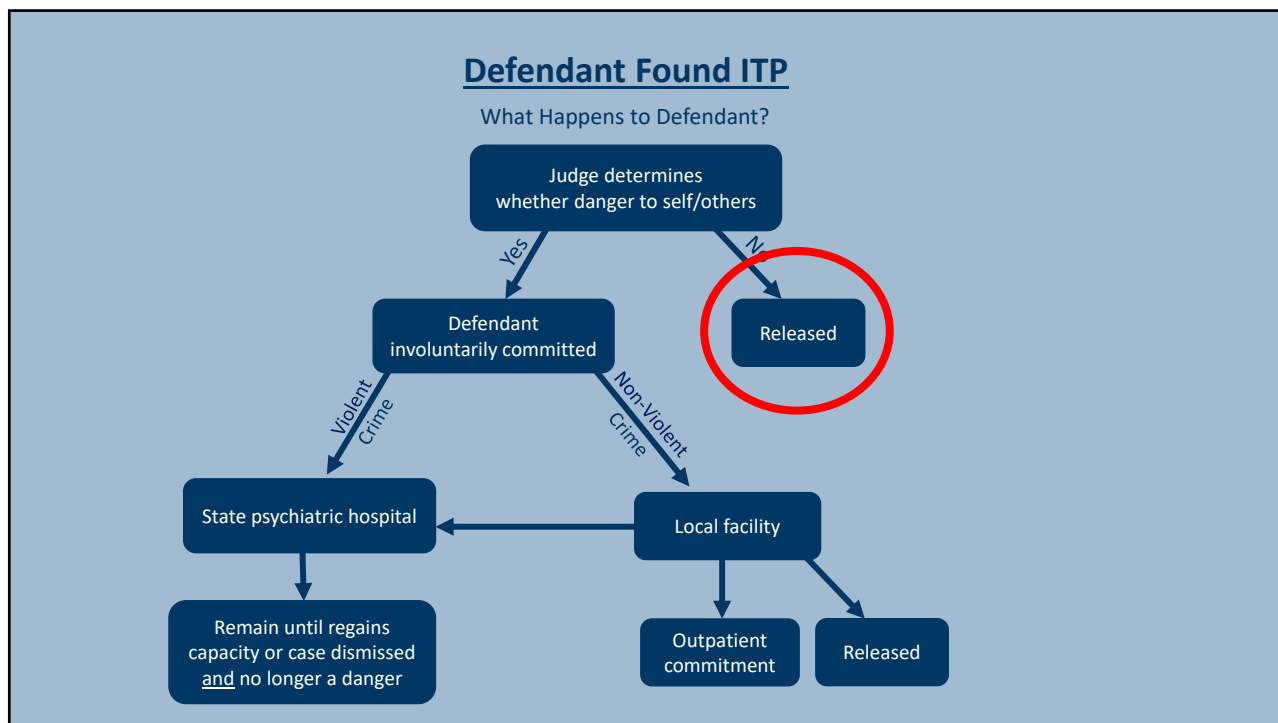

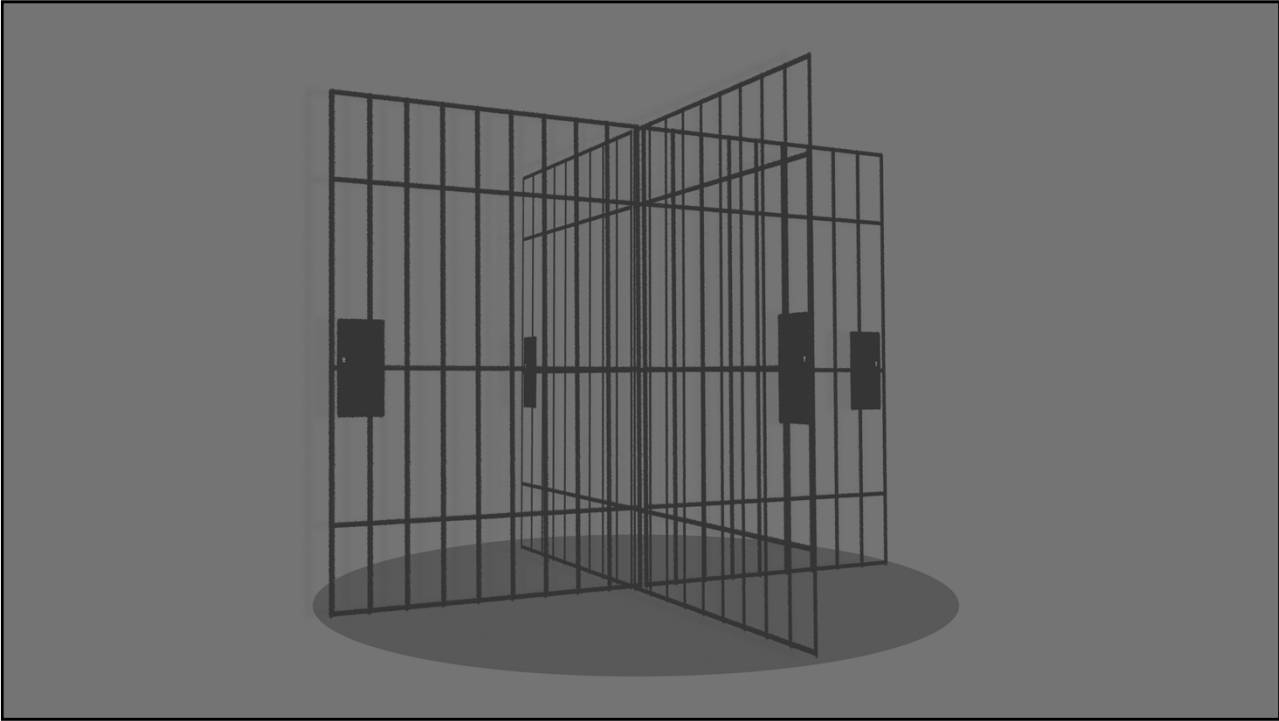

Judge shall determine whether there are reasonable grounds to believe that defendant meets criteria for involuntary commitment under Chapter 122C.

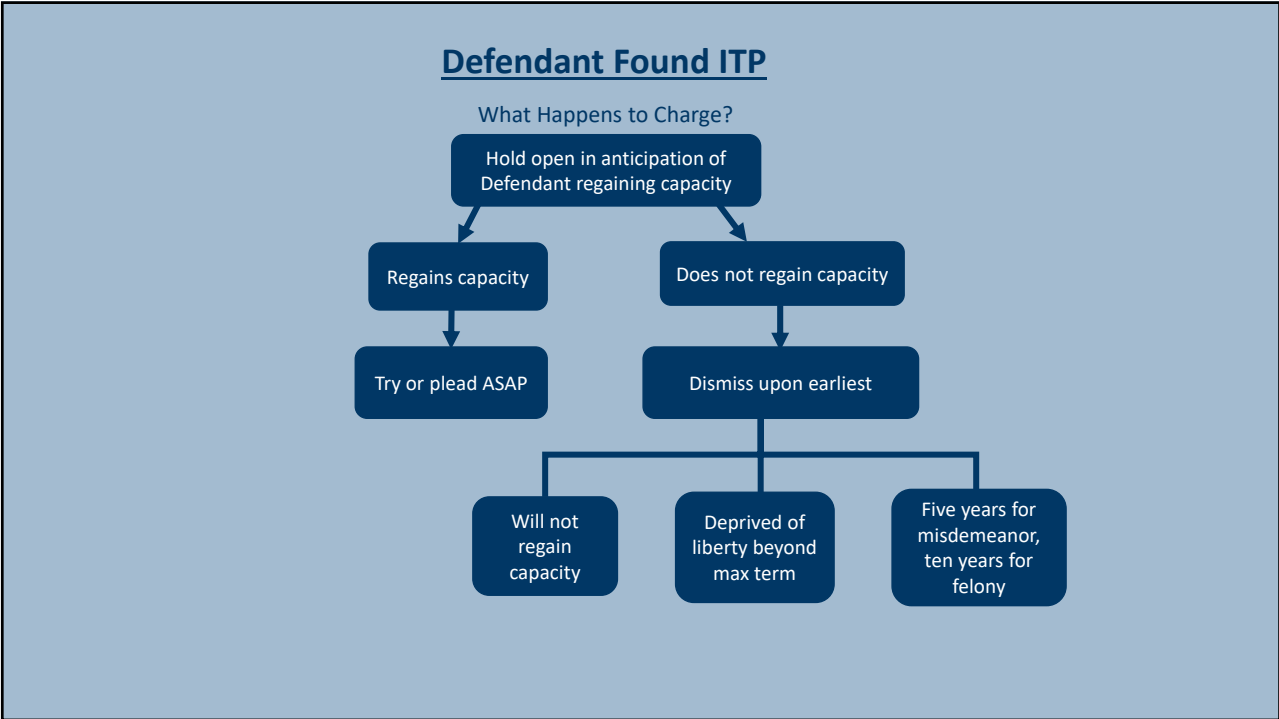

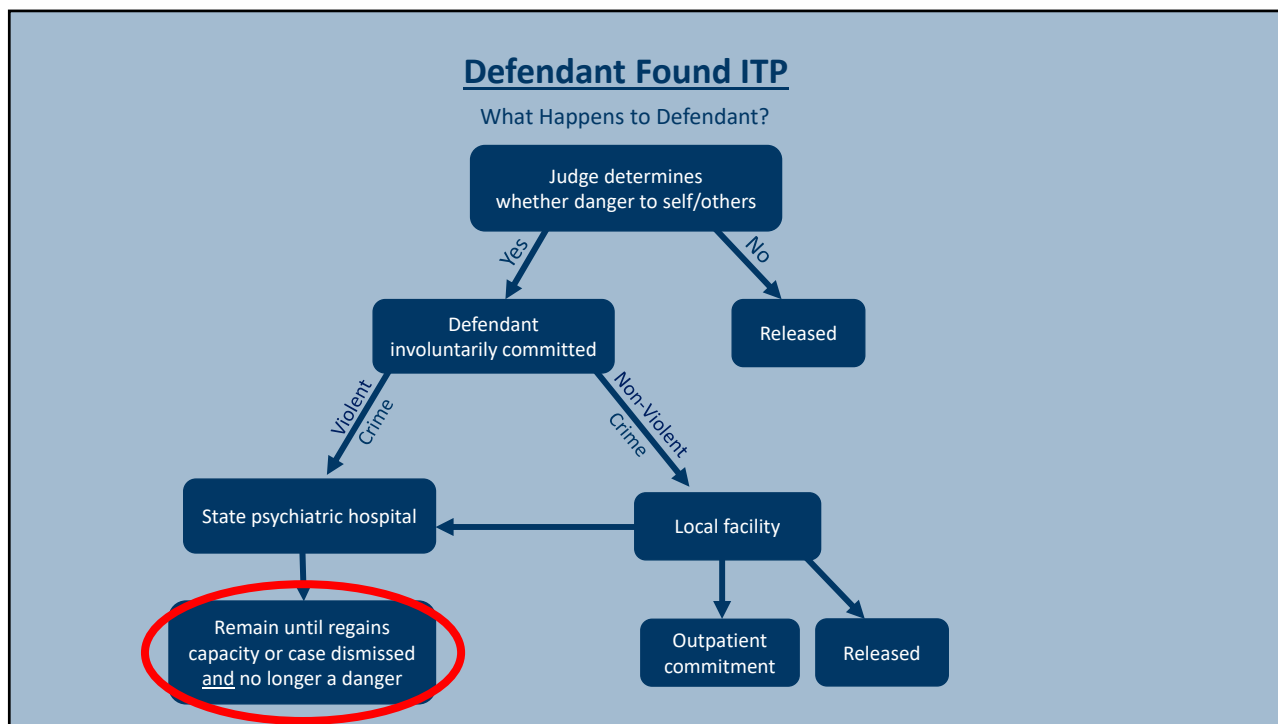
